In my multi-part installations I try to examine the dynamics between image, text, space and audience. There is a phase of collecting and archiving of visual, linguistic and acoustic material. After a constant subjective order and disorder, and the process of designing and discarding I try to install the various aspects to a logical visual dialogue.
